Changes to CRCS Morning Drop Off Routine

To make our morning drop off routine for the main school entrance between 8:10-8:30 am more efficient and safer, we will be instituting the procedures outlined below. Procedures for the middle school and preschool will not change. Thanks for your cooperation in this process.

1. To park and bring your child into the building:

Please use the Beulah St. entrance between the cemetery and sanctuary and park adjacent to the playground. Do not park on the school building side of the lot. Please observe the one way traffic flow in this area.

You may also enter the South parking lot from Charles Arrington Drive and park in that area and then escort your child into the building. Do not proceed past the playground gate as this is now one-way. Please

do not park in the circular curb as this is now for drop off only.

2. To drop your child off at the circular curb (when students are inside):

Please enter through the main Beulah St. entrance or the Charles Arrington Drive entrance. Follow all directional signs when pulling up to the curb and pull forward as far as possible to the front of the curb. Staff or safety patrols will assist students in exiting the car. Please carefully exit the parking lot as soon as your child has exited the car.

Students who arrive between 8:10-8:15 am will be directed up to extended care by safety patrol officers. After 8:15 am students will go directly to their classroom.

3. To drop your child off at the playground (when students are outside):

You may either use the Beulah St. entrance and park as in #1 above or enter through Charles Arrington Drive as in #2 above. Pull up alongside the playground where staff and safety patrols will assist your child out of the car. Continue around the curved lane and exit.

Changes to CRCS Car Line Procedures After School

To make the car line more efficient and safer for all of our families, we are requesting that the following procedures be followed by all individuals who use our car line. If there are other individuals who will be picking up your child on an occasional or regular basis, please make them aware of these procedures. Thanks for your cooperation.

1. Please drive slowly through the parking lot at all times.
2. For safety reasons, **ONLY** enter the car line from the north entrance of the rear parking lot (along the side of the church auditorium and cemetery) and remain in a single line of traffic while moving forward in the line.
3. If you prefer to park to get your child from the sidewalk where the students are waiting, please come to where your child is standing in the car line and pick up your child from his/her teacher. Students will not be permitted to walk to the

street or other locations. Please park in the large side parking lot to the south of the car line. Do not park in front of the playground.

4. Once in the car line do not leave your car to come inside the building or place your child in the car. We will assist your child getting into your car. If you have business inside the building, please park in a regular parking space in the large side parking lot to the south of the car line. Do not park in front of the playground.

5. Do not beep your horn at any time while in the car line.

6. After your child is buckled in, please pull out very carefully and proceed slowly if you are passing a car in front of you in the line.

7. The car line is from 3:15-3:30 pm. After 3:30 pm, any remaining children will be taken to extended care and charged the daily extended care fee.
