Clearance Process:

Volunteers at Calvary Road Christian School are required to complete a background check.

Volunteers will need to fill out clearances once every (3) years or as requested by the administration.

Volunteer Guidelines:

Respect Confidentiality:

• At Calvary Road Christian School, confidentiality is a priority for all students. Safeguarding information about a student's academic or home life is paramount, and as a volunteer, you play a crucial role in upholding this commitment. Confidentiality remains intact, unless there's a genuine concern for a student's safety. In such cases, it is imperative to promptly inform a staff member, recognizing that, as a volunteer, you are a mandated reporter obligated to report any observed or suspected child abuse to ChildLine (240-777-4417) as required by law.

Prioritize Safety and Health:

• As a volunteer, you contribute significantly to maintaining a safe and positive school environment. Vigilance in student safety is a shared responsibility among all volunteers. Volunteers should never be alone with a student. Being alone in a restroom with a student is strictly prohibited. Volunteers will use designated restrooms in the church foyer. Additionally, maintaining awareness of your surroundings while interacting with students ensures a proactive approach to their wellbeing. Volunteers are expected to monitor their own health and refrain from volunteering if experiencing any illness.

Exemplify CRCS Core Values:

• When working with students, your words and demeanor leave a lasting impression. Volunteers will follow our Core Values as a part of our school community. Our classroom teachers are the primary authority in the classroom and maintain overall responsibility for the class. Maintaining a friendly yet professional attitude enhances the learning environment. Focusing on the students in your care, silencing cell phones, and refraining from making or receiving calls or texts contribute to a professional atmosphere.

Embrace a Positive Attitude:

 Respect for each staff member and student as an individual is fundamental. If a student under your supervision requires guidance, addressing the situation with positivity fosters a supportive learning environment. A friendly demeanor with fellow staff, other volunteers, parents, and community members contributes to a positive school culture.

Commit to Service:

• Volunteers at Calvary Road Christian School commit to serving all students and they recognize the profound impact of positive connections. While it may be tempting to focus solely on your own child, remember that each child under your care can benefit from your support and guidance.

Be Dependable:

• Teachers and staff rely on volunteers to help facilitate seamless classroom activities, events, fundraisers, and student learning. Honoring your commitment and arriving punctually reflects your dedication to the school community's overall success.

CALVARY ROAD CHRISTIAN SCHOOL PVO AGREEMENT

I understand and agree that my involvement as a volunteer with Calvary Road Christian School is performed with and under the following provisions:

I will model behavior which aligns with CRCS Core Values:

- STAND ON GOD'S TRUTH- Committed to following and teaching the absolute truths of the Bible.
- PASSION FOR EXCELLENCE- An ongoing commitment to learn, grow, and strive for excellence in all things.
- SERVICE TO OTHERS- Intentionally love others as Jesus did.
- RESPECT- Value and treat all people with dignity because they are made in God's image.
- INTEGRITY- Build an open and honest communication within our community.
- SAFETY- Provide a safe and secure environment that encourages people to grow into the image of Christ.

I acknowledge and understand the following:

- I will not be paid any salary or stipend for my services.
- I will not be eligible for or request any benefits for my services.
- I will assume responsibility for my own personal injuries.
- I will familiarize myself with and adhere to the Volunteer Guidelines.
- I will accept direct and indirect supervision of the teacher, staff member, or administrator.
- I will not bring any other children into CRCS while I am volunteering.
- As a volunteer who works with children, I am a mandated reporter by law. If child abuse is observed or suspected, I will report it to ChildLine (240-777-2417).
- I will avoid all gossip, criticism, or other destructive talk concerning the school, its personnel, its curriculum, and methods of instruction, the PVO program, both in person and digitally. I will go first and directly to the person involved with any criticism or necessary confrontation, according to the steps of Matthew 18, before any other discussion of problems that might arise. I will bring any serious concerns to the Administration without delay, in place of public criticism.
- The administration may terminate my services as a volunteer at any time, with or without cause.
- I will abide by the requirements outlined in the Calvary Road Christian School parent handbook and student handbook.
